

Theatre MSU brings “A Christmas Carol” to Mississippi State.

With Theatre MSU’s first show, “The Little Mermaid”, coming to a successful close, the company is now gearing up for their winter show. This November, Theatre MSU is presenting their take on Charles Dicken’s “A Christmas Carol”. The showtimes are Nov. 16-18 at 7:30 PM and Nov. 19 at 2:00 PM. The show will take place on the McComas Hall stage at Mississippi State. The cast is also hosting meet and greet parties after each performance.

After each show fans will have a chance to meet all of their favorite characters. Tickets for the meet and greets are available on the Theatre MSU website through Nov. 15. There are only 30 tickets available for each post-show party. Free food and beverages will be provided with ticket purchases, as well as a chance for photo ops with the cast.

“Our post-show meet and greets give the cast a chance to hear feedback from their fans and give fans a chance to see the costumes up close and personal,” said Theatre Director Cody Stockstill.

For the first time, auditions this fall for the winter show were opened up to the Starkville community. “A Christmas Carol” will feature an exceptionally large cast made up of 43 Starkville residents and MSU students. The lead role of Ebenezer Scrooge was cast to John Brocato. A complete cast list is available on the Theatre MSU Facebook page.

The show will include everyone’s favorite characters, including Scrooge and Tiny Tim, but will portray a new variation of the plot. The company will be performing Michael Wilson’s stage adaptation, “A Christmas Carol: A Ghost’s Story of Christmas”.
